Creating a Favourite

A favourite allows a NEPT user to have a quick view of any non-emergency patient transports occurring today for their facility.			
1.	Select 'Confirmed' from under the 'Trips' section in the left hand navigation menu.	ionfirmed	
2.	Select the 'Filter' icon towards the top of the page.	All > Active = true > State = Confirmed
