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Ergometrine

Drug class

Oxytocic drug

Pharmacology

An ergot alkaloid with uterine smooth muscle contractile properties.

Metabolism

Ergometrine is mainly metabolised in the liver.

Indications

As per LifeFlight standard operating procedure (SOP)

Contraindications

- 1st, 2nd stages of labour
- Pre-eclampsia
- Severe fibroids
- Multiple pregnancy
- Moderate-to-severe cardiac disease
- Severe peripheral vascular disease

Schedule

• S4 (Restricted drugs).

Special notes

- Only credentialed QAS Flight paramedics are authorised to carry medications from the designated LifeFlight medication formulary.
- LifeFlight is responsible for the procurement of all medications in the LifeFlight response kits.

Adult/Paediatric dosages

As per LifeFlight standard operating procedures (SOP)



May only be administered on the authority of a LifeFlight Retrieval Medical Officer whilst under direct supervision.

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
