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## **Drug class**

Antihypertensive agent

## **Pharmacology**

Peripheral vasodilator with little effect on venous smooth muscle. Hydralazine interferes with calcium transport to relax arteriolar smooth muscle and lower blood pressure.

### Metabolism

Hydralazine is metabolised primarily by N-acetylation in the liver.

As per LifeFlight standard operating procedure (SOP)

- Idiopathic SLE
- Severe tachycardia
- Aortic/mitral stenosis
- Cor pulmonale
- Porphyria
- Constrictive pericarditis
- Dissecting aortic aneurysm

### **Schedule**

• S4 (Restricted drugs).

- Only credentialed QAS Flight paramedics are authorised to carry medications from the designated LifeFlight medication formulary.
- LifeFlight is responsible for the procurement of all medications in the LifeFlight response kits.

May only be administered on the authority of a LifeFlight Retrieval Medical Officer whilst under direct supervision.
