

Queensland Ambulance Service Tertiary Scholarship

The Queensland Ambulance Service (QAS) Tertiary Scholarship Program aims to financially support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students to complete their Bachelor studies at university. Students will also be supported to build their professional capabilities and experience to help with the transition to the workforce, through provision of a 12-week paid internship during the 2nd and 3rd years of university.

Upon completion of their degree, scholars are provided a direct opportunity to transition into QAS workforce (subject to successful completion of the QAS recruitment selection process and position availability in their chosen field).

Application dates

Applications close 1st August 2024

What you'll receive

A scholarship valued at \$5,000 per year for up to a maximum of 3 years to assist scholars with tuition and additional expenses throughout the duration of their degree.

A 12-week paid internship in a business unit relevant to your study during the 2nd and 3rd years of university.

We are offering five (5) Tertiary Scholarships in 2024.

Eligibility

You must:

- be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- have commenced or continued an undergraduate degree in Semester 1, 2024

- be enrolled at the census date
- be studying full time (minimum of four units per semester) with a grade point average (GPA) of 4 or above

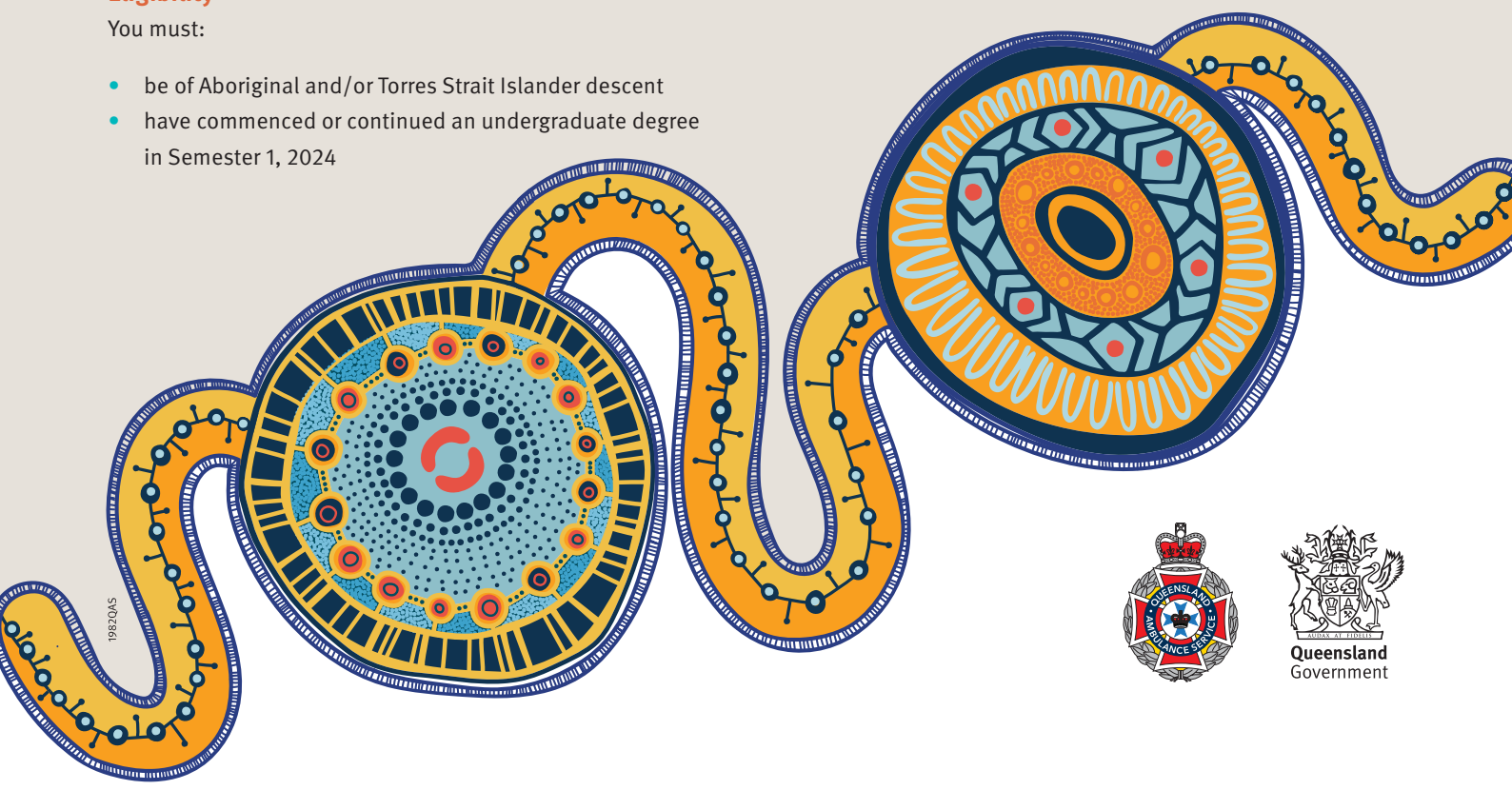



- Certified copy of documentation supporting Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage
- A current resume
- Referee reports
